

apache web server installation guide

System Requirements & Prerequisites

Before you begin, ensure your system meets the following prerequisites:

- Administrator or root access.
- Active internet connection for downloading packages.
- Enough disk space: at least 100 /MB for the core server and additional space for modules.
- Supported operating system version (e.g., Ubuntu 22.04 LTS, CentOS 8, Windows 10/11).
- Optional: SSL certificates if you plan to serve content over HTTPS.

Installing Apache on Linux

Ubuntu / Debian

1. Update your package list:

```
sudo apt update
```

- `sudo apt install apache2`

- `sudo systemctl status apache2`
- `sudo systemctl enable apache2`

CentOS / RHEL 7/8/9

1. Update the system:

`sudo yum update` (CentOS 7)

2. `sudo dnf update` (CentOS 8/9)

- `sudo yum install httpd` (CentOS 7)
- `sudo dnf install httpd` (CentOS 8/9)
- `sudo systemctl start httpd`
- `sudo systemctl enable httpd`
- `sudo firewall-cmd --permanent --add-service=http`
- `sudo firewall-cmd --permanent --add-service=https`
- `sudo firewall-cmd --reload`

Fedora

1. Update the system:

`sudo dnf upgrade`

- `sudo dnf install httpd`
- `sudo systemctl start httpd`
- `sudo systemctl enable httpd`
- `sudo firewall-cmd --permanent --add-service=http`
- `sudo firewall-cmd --permanent --add-service=https`
- `sudo firewall-cmd --reload`

Arch Linux

1. Update the package database:

`sudo pacman -Syu`

- `sudo pacman -S apache`
- `sudo ufw allow http`
- `sudo ufw allow https`
- `sudo systemctl start httpd`
- `sudo systemctl enable httpd`

Installing Apache on Windows

1. Download the latest Apache Lounge ZIP package from <https://www.apachelounge.com/download/>.
2. Extract the archive to C:\Apache24 (or another desired folder).
3. Open a Command Prompt as Administrator.
4. Navigate to the Apache bin directory:

`cd C:\Apache24\bin`

- `httpd.exe -k install -n "Apache2.4"`
- `httpd.exe -k start`

Installing Apache on macOS

1. macOS ships with Apache pre installed, but it is often outdated. The recommended approach is to install the latest version using Homebrew.
2. Install Homebrew if you haven't already:

```
/bin/bash -c "$(curl -fsSL https://raw.githubusercontent.com/Homebrew/install/HEAD/install.sh)"
```

- `brew install httpd`
- `sudo brew services start httpd`
